Welcome to Roady (“Roady”, “we”, “our”, or “us”).

Roady is a software-as-a-service platform that allows users to create, manage, and share public or private product roadmaps and changelogs.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you use Roady.

By accessing or using the Service, you agree to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Information We Collect

Account Information

When you create an account, we may collect:

- Name
- Email address
- Profile avatar or image (if provided)

Authentication is performed using passwordless email verification codes through NextAuth.

Roadmap and User Content

We collect and store content created through the platform, including:

- Roadmaps
- Roadmap items
- Status updates
- Changelog entries
- Public project information
- Feedback messages and ratings

You are responsible for the content you publish through the Service.

Public Content

Roadmaps, changelogs, and related content marked as public may be:

- accessible to anyone on the internet
- indexed by search engines
- shared externally
- cached by third-party services

Please carefully consider what information you choose to publish publicly.

Voting and Abuse Prevention Data

To prevent spam, abuse, fraudulent activity, and duplicate voting, we may collect and process:

- IP addresses
- browser identifiers
- device fingerprints
- session metadata

This information is used exclusively for platform integrity, fraud prevention, and security purposes.

Subscription and Billing Information

Paid subscriptions are processed securely by [Stripe](#).

We may receive limited billing-related information from Stripe, including:

- subscription status
- customer identifiers
- invoice metadata
- payment status

We do not store complete payment card information on our servers.

Technical Information

We may automatically collect technical and usage-related information, including:

- IP address
- browser type
- operating system
- device information
- authentication session data
- timestamps
- referral URLs
- interaction logs

This information helps us maintain platform reliability and security.

2. How We Use Information

We use collected information to:

- provide and operate the Service
 - authenticate users
 - maintain account security
 - process subscriptions and payments
 - display public roadmap content
 - prevent fraud and abuse
 - improve platform performance and reliability
 - respond to support requests
 - communicate important service-related information
 - comply with legal obligations
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3. Cookies and Authentication Technologies

Roady uses essential cookies and session technologies necessary for:

- authentication
- session management
- account security
- fraud prevention

These technologies are required for the proper operation of the Service.

Roady does not currently use advertising or behavioral marketing cookies.

4. Third-Party Services

Roady relies on third-party providers to operate portions of the Service.

These providers may process information as necessary to perform their services.
